Poster Preparation and Submission Instructions

Posters should be **concise, visual, and self-explanatory**, clearly communicating the research problem, approach, key findings, novelty, and renewable energy relevance.

1. Recommended Poster Structure

Section	Content
Background / Problem Statement	Research problem/gap and significance
Objective(s)	2–4 key objectives/questions
Methodology / Approach	Data, methods, model, experiment, prototype, or analytical approach
Key Results / Findings	Key findings supported by graphs, charts, maps, images or tables
Innovation / Novelty	Novel contribution of the research/technology
RE Relevance & Application	Application, scalability and deployment relevance
Conclusion / Key Takeaways	3–5 key conclusions
References / Acknowledgements	Key references and acknowledgements, if applicable
Contact / QR Code	Optional

For **skills/workforce and capacity-building research**, methodology and results may cover skill gaps, workforce requirements, training outcomes, and deployment/policy implications.

2. Poster Specifications

A0 (841 × 1189 mm), Portrait | PDF, max. 10 MB | 2–3 columns

Title: 60–80 pt | **Headings:** 32–40 pt | **Body:** ≥24 pt | **Captions/References:** ≥18 pt

Images/Graphics: 300 dpi preferred | **Readability:** approximately 1.5–2 metres

3. Preparation Guidelines

- Prioritise **key findings and visuals** over large blocks of text.
- Use high-quality graphs, diagrams, maps, photographs and schematics where relevant.
- Appropriately acknowledge external figures, data and other material.
- Place institutional/partner logos in the designated header.
- **Do not alter the prescribed BRESE 2026 branding.**

4. Submission

Submit the **300-word abstract (PDF)** and **A0 poster (PDF)** using the prescribed templates, along with applicant/institutional details and the originality declaration. **One presenting author** must be identified.

Selected Posters: The **Top 50 submissions** will be selected for display at **BRESE 2026**. Selected participants will be invited to present their research and will be required to bring a **print-ready poster in the prescribed format**.
